

Margaret Watt nee Redfern (1792 County Antrim, Northern Ire- died after 1851)

Sister of surgeon William Redfern

- Possibly step-sister with different mother given age difference.

- Married Andrew Watt in Belfast 1810. 7 children. Most family migrated to Australia about 1830.
-
- Belfast Newsletter 2 Jul 1811: Miss Fetherston's Young Ladies School. "*Miss Margt Watt*" won prizes Writing, English Grammar, Exemplary Conduct. The school was located 52 Castle St, not far from her brother's saddlery.
- Belfast Newsletter 29 Dec 1812: Miss Fetherston's Young Ladies School. "*Miss M. Watt*" won prizes Parsing, Recitation, Geography, Terrestrial Globe.
- Belfast Newsletter 5 Jul 1814: Miss Fetherston's Young Ladies School. "*Miss [Eliza] Redfern*" won awards for Recitation, Grammar, Spelling. "*Miss Margaret Watt*" won awards Parsing, Reading.

- 1 Jul 1825: Margaret Watt was bequeathed one-quarter of William Redfern's estate in his will if his sons were without issue.
- 6 Mar 1828: Margaret Watt was bequeathed £100 from William Redfern's estate in the codicil to his will.
- 6 Mar 1828: Niece Elizabeth Redfern Watt was bequeathed £20 per annum for the duration of apprenticeship in London and £100 on completion in accordance William Redfern's codicil.
- 6 Mar 1828: Nephews Hugh Watt and William Redfern Watt were to remain at school in Trowbridge until graduation and bequeathed £150 each when of age. Hugh and William arrived Sydney together in 19 Sep 1831 accommodated in Cabin in Princes Regent ship.

- Original (not recreated) 30 March 1851 Co Antrim census: aged 61 (b abt 1790), Widow, flax spinner, blind. Married 1810. Main St, Larne (same street as sister Eliza)
